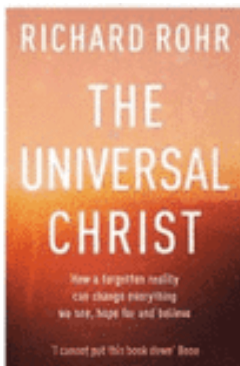
Saturday, May 18, at 5:00 p.m.

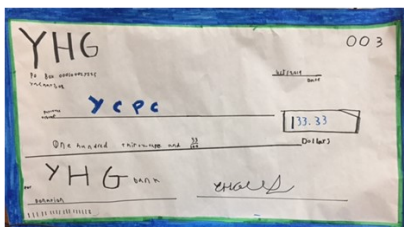

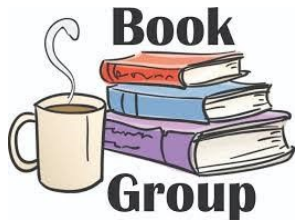
Summer Hymn Sing Begins Sunday, June 2

During the month of May the Book Group is reading any “self help” book, and then we’ll give mini book reports on what we’ve read.

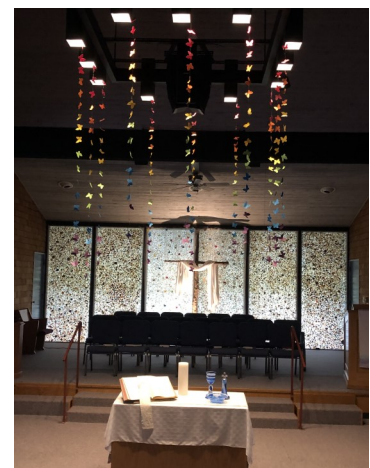
